## FOOTNOTES

1. University Core Curriculum Mathematics requirement can be fulfilled at SIUC by completing Mathematics 110, 113 or any higher level mathematics course numbered 108 or above with the exception of 114 and 282. To find a transferrable mathematics course to fulfill the University Core Curriculum Mathematics requirement, check the University Core Curriculum Substitution List for this school.

2. ENGL 101 and SPCM 101 are required; ENGL 102 is recommended.

Students must also complete 8 semester hours in one of the following areas: resort management, human resource management, food and nutrition management, foreign language or general management.

The transfer oriented associate degree (typically the Associate in Arts or Associate in Science) satisfies the University Core Curriculum requirements for general graduation purposes. Specific University Core Curriculum coursework required for the Hotel, Restaurant and Travel Administration degree is not automatically waived by the baccalaureate oriented degree.
