## Living Learning Communities

Living Learning Communities (LLCs) are residence hall communities that bring college learning into the everyday lives of students. They offer students the chance to live with others who share common interests and to interact with SIUC faculty and staff.

Students who participate in an LLC often have higher GPAs, more positive campus experiences and are more likely to graduate. Potential benefits include getting to know professors and classmates better, greater access to academic resources, and specialized programs right in your residence hall.

## To Get Into an LLC

You will have the opportunity to indicate an interest in your LLC while completing your Housing contract. If you are interested in a FIG, be sure to contact your Academic Advisor (contact information will be listed within the FIG description below) to discuss FIG options. You'll then choose your LLC when you go back online during your room selection period.

## 3 Types of LLCs

1. **Residential College LLCs** - a type of LLC where the college requires students to live in a specific area. If your college has a residential building and living requirement and you have been admitted to that program, you should only see that area when you go online to reserve your room. If you do not belong to the SIUC college, you cannot live in the Residential College. The Residential College(s) for Fall 09/Spring 10 is Engineering.

2. **Living Learning Communities** - These LLCs are restricted to certain majors and consist of a wing, floor or building - depending on the size of the community. In order to live in an LLC, you must meet eligibility requirements.
3. **Freshman Interest Groups (FIG)** - FIGs are for incoming freshmen who will be living on campus. Each FIG group of 10-20 students takes two-three classes together and lives on the same floor. All FIGs are nested within a larger Living Learning Community.
