The Elective Pass/NoPass form for student use with Spring 2020 final grades is coming **soon**. It is designed for those students who are unable to use SalukiNet SSB to elect Pass/NoPass grading because of a registration hold that is currently present on their student record.

Other than such a situation, it is highly recommended that the student use <u>SalukiNet SSB</u> to elect Pass/NoPass grading rather than using the form. It will be faster and more accurate for the student to use SSB.

However, if the student used SSB and made an election choice in error, the form will need to be used and submitted to the <u>Registrar's Office</u> to request that such choice be reversed. But please don't panic, because the form is coming **soon** and you'll be able to use it in this situation.

All election choices – whether done via SSB or via the form – must be completed by no later than Wednesday, May 20, so you still have plenty of time.



The Elective Pass/NoPass form for student use with Fall 2020 final grades is not guite ready yet.

The form will be made available here <u>later in the week of December 7</u>. It will be designed for those students who are unable to use SalukiNet SSB to elect Pass/NoPass grading because of a registration hold present on their student record.

Other than such a situation, it is highly recommended that the student use <u>SalukiNet SSB</u> to elect Pass/NoPass grading rather than using the form. It should be faster and easier for the student to use SSB than to fill out the form.

Students should consider carefully the implications of choosing Pass/NoPass grading, as doing so may – in certain cases – impact their financial aid or scholarships, as well as their future educational or employment opportunities. Students should check with their academic advisor or program director before making Pass/NoPass choices.

With that said, if the student uses SSB and makes an election choice in error, then the form will need to be used and submitted to the <u>Registrar's Office</u> to request that such choice be reversed.

All election choices – whether done via SSB or via the form – will need to be completed by the undergraduate or graduate student by no later than the end of the day on Wednesday, December 16.



The solicitation period for undergraduate and graduate students to elect Pass/NoPass grading for their Spring 2021 courses lasted from May 10 through May 16. The opportunity to elect Pass/NoPass grading has now ended.



The Registrar's Office is finalizing the Spring 2020 Elective Pass/Fail information and instructions as the University Administration is still weighing the most beneficial grading path to take with regard to student success in this unprecedented time of the COVID-19 pandemic.
